I am directed to refer your proposal for Starting of MD(Pathology) course at Government Medical College, Ananthapuram under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the I.M.C Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21.

It is to inform that the Board of Governors at its meeting held on 09/07/2019 considered the Council Assessor's report (11/06/2019) together with the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Government Medical College, Ananthapuram under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for Starting of MD(Pathology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21 and decided as under:

"The Board of Governors considered the Council Assessor's Report (11/06/2019) together with the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) and decided to issue Letter of Permission for Starting of MD(Pathology) course at Government Medical College, Ananthapuram under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2020-2021 restricting the number of admissions to 4(Four) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956."

It is also to inform that the Board of Governors further decided that Letter of Permission for **Starting of MD(Pathology)** course **for 4(Four)** seats as per available facilities, with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2020-21 at **Government Medical College, Ananthapuram** u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 may be issued.

In view of the above decision, the Council has decided to obtain undertaking/ essential documents for issue of Letter of Permission for starting/ increase in seats for the academic year 2020-21:-

- 1. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.
- 2. No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal permission of the Board of Governors is granted.
- 3. The Private Medical College should provide Bank Guarantee of required amount in favour of Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for three years from a nationalized/ scheduled Bank
