- In the G.C. ist read above the Government have granted Essentiality Certificate to M/s. Ananthapur Hedical College Trust. Ananthapur for establishment of Hedical College at Ananthapur subject to estain conditions indicated therein. Accordingly H/s. Ananthapur Hedical College Trust have made an application to Government of India for grant of permission for sarting of Hedical College at Ananthapur.
- 2. In the litter 2nd cited the Government of India have returned the application of M/s. Ananthapur Bedical College Trust on the ground that the Trust is not having its own Hospital of 300 beds and financial status of the Trust is not sound.
 - 3. As the Trust is not in a position to meet the above expenditure and establish the Medical College at anantaper. Government have decided to take ever the medical College from Trust and to establish the same as a Government Medical College at Ananthapur.
 - Anantapur have visited Ananthapur Medical College building which is under construction and also the APVVP Hospital at Ananthapur on 1-8-99 and submitted its seport to Government. The team of Officers have also reported that an amount of No. 54.22. crores is required ever a period of five year ier, from 1899-2000 to 2003- 2004 towards recurring, hom-recurring, and Civil Norks for

S. The Government after careful examination of the above matter have decided to take over the Medical College at Anantapur and establish the same as a Government Medical College at Anantapur. Further, the Rs.190.27 lakhs during the financial year 1999-2000 for creation of the posts which are required at the time of inception of the new Medical College for admitting 100 students as required under section 10 (A) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

The Government after careful examination of the above matter hereby accord sanction for release of an Education over a period of 5 years from 1999-2000 to Trust and establishment of a Government Medical College at Aninthapur. Further the Government also accord (Rupees one exore ninety lakhs and twenty seven thousand only) during this financial year 1899-2000 towards recurring and non-recurring expenditure as detailed
